Requirements for a minor in Japanese – N607

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

At least six (6) hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, that is, *excluding* transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

Students must successfully complete at least 18 hours of coursework in Japanese, including at least nine (9) hours at the upper-division level. Note that introductory courses (JAPN 1115 and 1225) are *not* counted toward this total. The following specific requirements must be met:

2. JAPN 2113
3. JAPN 2223
4. JAPN 3013 or 3133
5. Six (6) hours to be chosen from any Japanese 3000- or 4000-level course or MLLL 3223, 3233, 3623, 3633, or 4183

No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Japanese program in the Department of Modern Languages, Linguistics, and Literature.

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
