Requirements for a minor in Philosophy – N765

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

At least six (6) credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, *excluding* transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

Students must successfully complete at least 18 hours of courses acceptable for major credit in Philosophy, including at least nine (9) hours at the upper-division level. The following specific requirements must be met:

1. PHIL 1103 or 1113
2. PHIL 3313 or 3333
3. One (1) course from one of the following areas:
Aesthetics, Ethics, Philosophy of Religion, Social Philosophy, Political Philosophy
4. Additional Philosophy courses to complete the 18-hour requirement

No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement.
A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement.
Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Department of Philosophy.

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements.
No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
